Statement of purpose should outline objectives that match the philosophy and focus of the program	
you have selected	
Resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV) submitted	
International Applicants: TOEFL, IELTS, or MELAB scores sent to SOPHAS	
You are exempt from this requirement if you are from one of the countries on this list:

Second Step: Complete UF Application for Graduate Admission	
If Statement of Purpose and Letters of Recommendation have been submitted through SOPHAS, you do	
not need to duplicate these in the UF Application.

Official GRE scores arranged to be sent to UF (Code: 5812)	
Official Transcripts arranged to be sent to UF	
International Applicants: TOEFL, IELTS, or MELAB scores arranged to be sent to UF
