DEADLINES

The deadline to apply to the PhD in Public Health Program is **December 1st**.

Since it can often take more time for documents from institutions in other countries to be received, we recommend that international applicants begin the application process early.

	Official Transcripts arranged to be sent to SOPHAS and the University of Florida International applicants must submit a World Education Services (WES) evaluation in lieu of official transcripts
	3 Letters of Recommendation arranged to be sent to SOPHAS At least two letters must exhibit research acumen
	One-page Statement of Purpose submitted The following should be included in the statement of purpose: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Your background, experience, and other inspirations that make our programs of interest to you• Since an advisor match is part of the admission process, your thoughts on which faculty member(s) might best support your program and why you want to work with them, if admitted.• How this degree will support your career goals and aspirations.
	Resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV) submitted
	Quantitative Experiences Statement (one to two pages, single spaced) Please summarize the strength of your quantitative and analytical skills by (a) referencing your grades in key math and science-related coursework and (b) discussing specific details of any research or work experiences that involved quantitative and analytical tasks. The information provided will contribute to our holistic review process.
	International Applicants: TOEFL, IELTS, or MELAB scores sent to SOPHAS and UF You are exempt from this requirement if you are from one of the countries on this list: (admissions.ufl.edu/apply/international/countries.html)
