DEADLINES

The deadline to apply to the PhD in Public Health Program is **December 1st**.

Since it can often take more time for documents from institutions in other countries to be received, we recommend that international applicants begin the application process early.

	3 Letters of Recommendation arranged to be sent to the University of Florida application At least two letters must exhibit research acumen
	One-page Statement of Purpose submitted The following should be included in the statement of purpose: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your background, experience, and other inspirations that make our program of interest to you • Since an advisor match is part of the admission process, your thoughts on which faculty member(s) might best support your program and why you want to work with them, if admitted • How this degree will support your career goals and aspirations
	Resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV) submitted
	Statement of Previous Training and Preparation (maximum one page, single spaced) Please summarize the skills you have obtained during your preparation for your selected graduate degree that will enable you to succeed in our program. This should not be a list, but a narrative that describes your previous training and experience and how you can apply your skills to your graduate program. Experiences can include, but are not limited to, specific coursework, quantitative or qualitative skills, research experience, previous work experience, and other additional trainings. The statement should be no longer than one page, single spaced, 11-point font, 1 inch margins. Please do not exceed 1 page, the goal is to be clear and concise.
	International Applicants: TOEFL, IELTS, or MELAB scores sent to UF You are exempt from this requirement if you are from one of the countries on this list: (admissions.ufl.edu/apply/international/countries.html)
